SUBJECT: Big Brothers Big Sisters of Northwestern Wisconsin ... Who we are, What we do, How you can be a part of it.

Big Brothers Big Sisters has been around for about 50 years under various names, one being Kinship. It does both "Community-Based" Mentoring and "Site-Based" Mentoring.

"Community-Based" Mentoring is where the child and adult meet for an average of one-hour per week doing activities in the community such as going for a picnic, going to a ball game, doing a craft, fishing, going to a movie, etc.

"Site-Based" Mentoring is more structured with the child and adult meeting at a set day or time at school of a specific site. All activities are done at the site. This is currently not offered in Chippewa County due to the fact it is already being offered through the Mentor Chippewa program.

BBBS has an impressive record for making a difference in a child's life vs. a child that is not part of BBBS. BBBS kids are 47% less likely to begin using illegal drugs ... 54% less likely to skip school.

Currently BBBS is serving 188 kids/families in the five country area of Chippewa, Dunn, Eau Claire, Buffalo and St. Croix.

They have about 40 kids in those five counties waiting for a match ... 10 of those kids are in Chippewa County ... 20 are in Eau Claire County. Ages range from 7 to 14.

All volunteers go through an extensive screening system to assure the safety of the children. Volunteers are asked for a one-year commitment.

* Mission Update: CFMC May "Lather With Love" Soap Mission (Tom Drehmel) The number of soap/health items gathered this year were down a bit from previous years, partly due to the fact we moved "LWL" from February to May because of the "Help For The Homeless" Hygiene drive being held in February. We did this so we weren't competing for the same items at the same time.

The good news is when we look at both missions, they combined to collect a lot more soap/health than if we had just done one gathering. So we can consider that a big win for those in need of those soap/health care items. "Yay God!"

In any case, "Lather With Love" gathered 1.328 soap/health care items that were evenly distributed to the following local food pantries ... First Presbyterian, English Lutheran of Bateman, Valley Vineyard, St. Francesca, Legacy Center and L.E. Phillips CDC Outreach Center in Chippewa Falls. That's another "Yay God!"

* Mission Update: Hope Village. (Mike Cohoon)

Progress has slowed a bit on our Hope Village Capital Campaign. We are currently at \$2.2 million with about \$500,000 to go. Donations continue to come in, but we could use a boost to get us to our goal. These funds are needed for the next stage of Hope Village where we start construction on the affordable housing units. In addition to donations, prayers are also welcomed.

Currently 9 of the 10 Tiny Houses are occupied at Hope Village, as well as the one Tiny House at Chippewa Valley Bible Church.

Bike racks for Hope Village have been provided by the Chippewa Leadership group through the Chippewa Falls Chamber if Commerce. Bikes have also been donated; more could be used.

We are still looking for volunteers to be in the Community Building so our Tiny House guests have access to the building. You can sign up for one or two hour shifts. You can watch TV, work on the computer, read, bring your bible study or card group, bring your child with you, etc. Mike is usually there from 10 to 4. As far as needs for Hope Village, paper towels continue to be at the top of the list.

We'd love a chance to present Hope Village to churches and other organizations. Again, contact Mike Cohoon and he can make that happen.

He showed us the plans for this building and donors/supporters are already being contacted.

Lilly's Place will be an LLC, similar to Hope Village. It will be separate from Valley Vineyard Church. Its purpose will be to provide a safe haven for children at risk, as well as working with their parents. It will provide information, counselors and support to hopefully prevent future tragedies like Lilly's.
